Job Purpose:

To calibrate, test and maintain environmental monitoring equipment.

This role involves attendance at the Stockport office to complete your duties. From time to time you may be required to travel throughout the UK to assist in site deployments, training and company events.

Key Accountabilities

Equipment Technician

- 1. To calibrate, test and maintain equipment, and take appropriate records and assist with data quality control, compensation and optimisation.
- 2. To assist in the management, tracking and storage of stock.
- 3. This is a dynamic role and must develop to meet the needs of the business. As such the successful candidate must be flexible with the desire to learn and progress.
- 4. Willingness to learn and use computer software packages.
- 5. Equipment rooms and contents therein to be kept in a clean and tidy state.
- 6. Work with other members of staff, to provide an efficient, profitable and professional service;

General Responsibilities

- 7. The employee will carry out their duties with full regard to the company's Health & Safety and Environmental Policies and any other company policies relevant to their role.
- 8. Maintain the professional image of the company;
- 9. To assist and represent the company at industry specific events;
- 10. To work from time to time at project and office locations elsewhere in the UK;
- 11. Willing to stay overnight as business needs require;
- 12. To undertake such additional duties to support the business that are reasonably commensurate with, or lesser than, the level of the role;
