About the role

We are seeking a motivated and independent individual with practical experience of construction site environments to join our team on a full-time basis. The role involves predominantly site-based work, specifically focused on the verification of ground gas protection measures and ground gas monitoring, and is ideal for someone eager to grow their career within the industry.

The role is based from our Stevenage office, but the site work would involve sites across the UK and occasionally beyond.

In this role you will:

- Conduct on-site verification of ground gas protection measures for projects across the UK.
- Adhere to and enforce ground gas safety standards and protocols on-site.
- Collaborate with construction teams and stakeholders to ensure quality standards are met.
- Maintain accurate records of site activities and report progress to project managers.
- Demonstrate a strong understanding of construction processes and materials.
- Undertake ground gas monitoring at sites across the UK.

Essential skills, knowledge and experience

- At least one year of experience working on construction sites.
- Good understanding of construction safety practices and site operations.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced construction site environment.

As a resident verification specialist, site deployments will typically be from Mondays to Fridays, as well as occasional weekend work at key project stages.

There will also be trips to our head office in Stockport (e.g. for training, company events).
